**Adult Vocational Educational Centers**

Adult Vocational Technical Colleges and Skill Centers offer high school credit programs which provide an opportunity for students, ages 16 and over, to return to school and earn a high school diploma. Instruction is aligned to the regular 9-12 high school program, and covers all required benchmarks and testing. Students are placed on an individualized instructional plan so that instructors can differentiate their instruction to target identified student needs. While enrolled in the high school program, students select a Career Technical Education (CTE) Academy to attend.

**Description:** Miami Dade County Public Schools (MDCPS) has partnered with the Juvenile Justice System as well as several community partners to provide transitional services assisting adjudicated students in their transition back to an appropriate educational settings that will ensure student success at one central location: *"One-Stop Educational and Community Service Center."*

**Onsite Educational Services**

- Comprehensive multi-disciplinary educational assessment and recommendations.
- Referral to appropriate Miami-Dade County Public Schools support services.
- Transition advisement and placement in a K-12, high school, or GED completion program.
- Transition advisement and placement in an adult/vocational/technical education program
- Educational case management and academic progress monitoring.
- Specialized educational services that utilize family and community interventions and support.
- Alternative to suspension services.

**Alternative Education Specialized Centers**
