The One Stop Educational & Community Service Center represents a partnership between the Juvenile Justice System and Miami Dade County Public Schools (MDCPS) as well as numerous community-based organization partners. Specialized support and interventions are available at each of the three centralized locations in the North, Central and South areas of Miami-Dade County. The One Stop Educational and Community Service Center Specialists coordinate the academic, social, emotional, health, personal, and career needs of families and students who have been referred by the Students Success Center (SSC) Program, the Secondary Student Success (S3C) Program and those who are transitioning out of the Juvenile Justice System.
