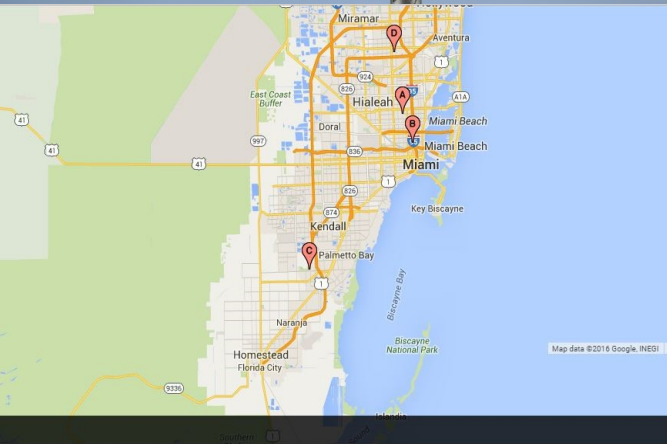

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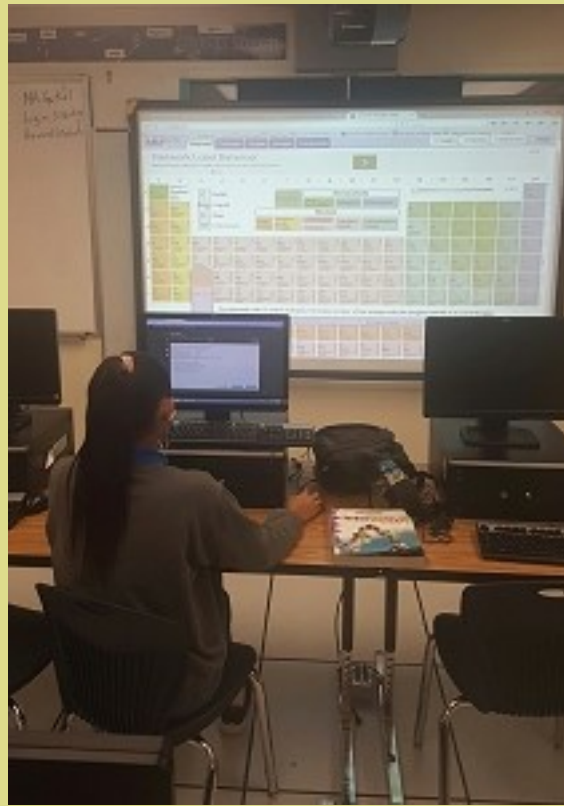
Secondary Student Success Center (S3C)

The Secondary Student Success Center (S3C) touts a blended model of small group and computer based instruction. Each student will work on an individualized program to complete courses. The program is designed to provide an accelerated educational experience for students.

In order to be eligible for the program, students must meet the following criteria:

- Grade 6 - 13 years old or older and have attempted middle school courses.
- Grade 7 - 14 years old or older.
- Grade 8 - 15 years old or older.

Ability to work on a computer for extended periods of time



Program Expectations

- Student will adhere to the S3C uniform policy.
- Student will arrive to school and class on time, prepared with and assigned work.
- Student will show respect for self, peers, teachers and all other members of the community.
- Student will turn off all electronic devices in class.
- Student will work on teacher designated web sites/programs
- Student will follow classroom rules and teacher, and school staff directions.
- Student will maintain a minimum 2.0 GPA and have a minimum of 4 course completions per semester.
